ARTIST OF THE MONTH ONLINE RETURNS

As many of you may recall, East Valley Artists ran our Artist of the Month competition completely online while we hunkered down to avoid the Coronavirus.

Looking back, there were very few months, if any, that we did not have the minimum number of submissions required to run the contest, so we've decided to resume

Artist of the Month Online (AOMO). In 2023, we will be accepting AOMO submissions for at least the first three months. If all goes well, we will continue AOMO for the rest of 2023.

There are at least three key issues the board will use to determine whether "all goes well."

- 1. How well do our members follow the submissions requirements for the images they send in? Do the files fall within the size limits and are they named properly? The names of correctly labelled files carry important information. Whoever is working with the file has the information needed to integrate the file into the AOMO voting system in hand at any given time. Additionally, reformatting and renaming files from multiple people results in too heavy a work load for the volunteers who run the competition.
- 2. Is there enough participation to justify the work put in?
- 3. Finding a volunteer or a small team of volunteers to run the competition. We need someone to pitch in and take this project off of the board's hands. We need a volunteer who is comfortable working with images and software programs, someone familiar with social media, and someone to help with basic administrative stuff like mailing certificates to winners and keeping records from month to month. Therefore, read the submission guidelines carefully so that you can send us correctly formatted and labelled images and consider volunteering to help run AOMO. Links to submission guidelines and deadlines plus voting details may be found under the "For Members" header at our website.

And, in the meantime, start working on that masterpiece you've been thinking about and watch your email for a password that will allow you to vote. We will be sending it out nearer to our first voting date, January 19, 2023.


